All fees are per annum unless otherwise stated and additional professional accreditation fees may also apply.

Tuition fees are charged annually and may be subject to an annual increase. Information about the current level of tuition fees can be found above.

The UK government caps the annual fee that English universities are permitted to charge UK and EU undergraduate students. It is the UK government's intention that the cap will increase in line with the RPIX measure of inflation (the Retail Prices Index, excluding mortgage interest payments) for higher education providers participating in the Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF). The RPIX is a variable measure and as at September 2017 stood at 2.8%.

The next increase would be applied to the tuition fee payable for the 2018/19 academic year. It would be applied to students beginning their courses in that year and those continuing their courses from previous years.

Any increase to the tuition fee cap requires parliamentary approval. The government has not yet introduced the legislation necessary to increase the fee cap for the 2018/19 academic year. Therefore, the level of tuition fee we charge for the 2018/19 academic year will be dependent on this legislation passing through parliament.

We will notify students immediately if that happens and in any event no later than 30 June 2018 of the tuition fee to be charged for the academic year 2018/19.
