The data set comprises three parts: 15 nonsense words, 20 single words based on authentic clinical data and 5 sentences, also based on clinical data. Each word/sentence will be said 3 times.

Use broad phonetic transcription: you do <u>not</u> need to indicate allophonic variants such as aspirated plosives or dark [†]. However, you will need to indicate connected speech process, eg any examples of assimilation or liason across word boundaries, where these occur in the connected speech data. You do <u>not</u> need to indicate stress in either the single words or the connected speech data.
